A search for outstanding High School Students in the performing arts!

What is the TALENT HUNT? The Talent Hunt is an international performing arts contest, established to provide exposure, encouragement and financial assistance to talented young people. Since it's inception in 1946, this program has been used to find and to showcase High School Students, grades 9-12—with outstanding abilities in the performing arts.

Who sponsors the competition? The competition is annually sponsored by Chapters of the Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc. The graduate Brothers of Sigma Rho Chapter sponsor the Greater Ann Arbor—Ypsilanti Area program.

When and where is it? This year's local competition will be held on Sunday, March 17, 2019—4:00pm in the Slauson Middle School auditorium • 1019 W. Washington St. • Ann Arbor, MI 48103. The Parent/Student Orientation is on Thursday, February 28—6:00pm in the Slauson Middle School auditorium Subsequent rehearsals will be held in the Slauson Middle School auditorium.

What can I win? Participants can win monetary prizes and awards. This is a progressive international competition. Winners receive prizes and paid travel at each level. Local winner receives \$200 and an all expense paid trip the 10th District competition in Madison, Wisconsin on April 12, 2019. The district winner receives \$800 and an all expense paid trip to perform in a demonstration program, during our International Leadership Conference in Atlantic City, New Jersey—July 9-14, 2019. Leadership Conference participants receive \$1,000.

How do I sign-up to compete? If you are in 9th-12th grade and attend a school in the Greater Ann Arbor—Ypsilanti area, please call or E-mail Mr. Jay S. Attend the rehearsals...then bring your best performance to the competition on **Sunday, March 17, 2019—4:00pm!**

All performances must be solo and memorized. Performance categories include vocal, instrumental, dance, drama, poetry and oratory. Vocal and instrumental selections must be classical, semiclassical, jazz or gospel—no rap.
